Project Location	Jorhat
Area of the project	123 acres

Focus sector	Food Processing
Status of approvals	Pre-feasibility for the park has been prepared and approved by the concerned authority
Project contours	The proposed site is in the district of Jorhat, which is in the highest tea producing region in Assam Jorhat is expected to transform into a Class I town within the next 10 years The Numaligarh refinery is located at a distance of 66 km from Jorhat via NH37.
Investment Opportunities	Being the largest tea producing region of Assam, good investment opportunities exists along the different activities of tea value chain
Connectivity	Jorhat is well connected by NH37 which connects it to Guwahati and all the other district of Assam on the southern bank of river Brahmaputra It is well connected to Dibrugarh in the east and Guwahati and to the rest of India on the west Jorhat airport is the third largest airport in Assam The nearest IWT Terminal is at Neamati which is ~ 17 km from Jorhat Town
Proposed Infrastructure	A new power generation plant of 50 MW is coming up at Amguri, which is at a distance of ~ 38 km from the proposed site. Natural gas will be made available to the site from the existing terminal at Duliajan Private as well as public telecom service providers provide extensive service in this region. Internet and telecom services are provided by mobile companies such as Airtel, Vodafone, Aircel, and BSNL in the district.
