Project contours	<p>There exists significant potential to add value by promoting end user petrochemical industries in Assam.</p> <p>There already exist petrochemical industries based on PVC, HDPE, LLDPE & Polypropylene products which have experienced impressive growth trends in the past</p> <p>Assam has four refineries and together they produced 146 TMT and 259 TMT of LPG and Naphtha respectively in 2012 – 13.</p>
Investment Opportunities	<p>There is a demand for organic chemicals in the Indian domestic market</p> <p>Strong demand for cosmetics in India and Demand for chemicals from neighbouring countries such as Bhutan and Bangladesh</p> <p>Downstream units of petro chemicals using the feedstock available locally</p>
Connectivity	<p>Chandrapur is well connected by SH3, which runs from Narengi to Nagaon where it intersects NH37. SH3B also connects SH3 to NH37 at Chamtapathar</p> <p>The rail connects the proposed site to West Bengal and beyond to the rest of India towards west. Towards east, the trunk route connects Chandrapur to Dibrugarh</p> <p>The nearest airport is the Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport at Guwahati which is at a distance of ~ 42 km from Chandrapur.</p> <p>The nearest IWT Terminal is at Pandu, which is at a distance of ~ 31 km from Chandrapur</p>
Proposed Infrastructure	<p>The nearest IWT Terminal is at Pandu, which is ~ 31 km from Chandrapur in addition to the 60MW power plant nearby</p> <p>Adequate water will be made available from ground and surface to meet the needs of the units in the proposed park</p> <p>The state gas company will extend the existing pipe line to the proposed site</p> <p>Private as well as public telecom service providers provide extensive service in this region</p>
