Project contours	<p>The population of Guwahati is expected to increase from the 2011 figure of 1,209,908 to 1,706,233 by 2025 and 2,205,530 by 2035.</p> <p>The total waste generated is expected to be 932 TPD and 1375 TPD by 2025 and 2035 respectively, and accordingly the treatment capacity will have to be increased.</p> <p>For 100% coverage, the network will have to cover 396,798 houses and 512,914 houses by 2025 and 2035 respectively.</p> <p>The project envisages the complete range of activities involved in solid waste management i.e. from collection to scientific disposal including composting.</p>
