Project contours	<p>With growth of commercial, industrial and institutional activities across both banks of river Brahmaputra in Guwahati, commuting across the river has increased manifold. Most of the commuters are presently using country boats and ferries for crossing the river. Country boats are not the safest means of transport especially during the monsoons and flooding season.</p> <p>The proposed mass transit ropeway will act as a safe and convenient mode of commuting. Also, a halt in Umananda will enable hundreds of tourist visiting the temple island daily to use the ropeway.</p>

Connectivity	North Guwahati is connected with rest of Guwahati through excellent network of Roads and Ferries, which ply on River Brahmaputra. Guwahati Railway Station, the nearest station, is 7 km from North Guwahati by ferry and Guwahati Airport is 40 km away.
Proposed Infrastructure	Proposed Infrastructure shall consist of a Bi-cable ropeway system with a carrying capacity of 600-700 passengers per hour during peak flow.
