Project contours	<p>The population of Dibrugarh is expected to increase from the 2011 figure of 138,661 to 213,433 by 2025 and 286,840 by 2035.</p> <p>Dibrugarh being a Class I town, the total waste generated is expected to be 83 TPD and 128 TPD by 2025 and 2035 respectively, and accordingly the treatment capacity will have to be increased.</p> <p>For 100% coverage, the network will have to cover 49,636 houses and 66,707 houses by 2025 and 2035 respectively.</p> <p>The project envisages the complete range of activities involved in solid waste management i.e. from collection to scientific disposal including composting.</p>
